WEBSITE

- Public Website (fmcquaker.org): Information about worship, upcoming events, community, and witness at FMC. *Accessible to the public.*
- Community Website (community.fmcquaker.org): The Community Pages of the FMC website are here to host documents, links and other resources to be shared among individuals and committees within the FMC community. *Password protected - request access when you first visit the website.*

PUBLICATIONS

- Weekly Announcement Sheets: 2-page news-in-brief about events and activities for the upcoming week. *Detailed version available at FMC, on community site (community.fmcquaker.org), and via email. Version without individual contact information available on public site (fmcquaker.org).*
- Monthly Newsletter: Includes community updates, announcements, reflections, and a longer-term calendar. *Available at FMC, on the community website (community.fmcquaker.org), and via email.*
- Monthly Minutes & Reports: Committee and staff reports, as well as Meeting for Business in Worship minutes. *Available at FMC, on the community website (community.fmcquaker.org), and via email.*
- FMC Directory: Published once a year (typically in October), this lists contact info for individuals as well as clerk and membership info for FMC committees. *Hard copies available in the FMC office; electronic version available on community website (community.fmcquaker.org).*

EMAIL LISTS

- Official FMC News List: For administrative use only. Friends who receive the Newsletter via email are added to receive these communications (0-3/month) but are welcome to opt out. Anyone in the community may opt in.
- FMC Community Listserv: Announcements, invitations, and appeals about happenings we're involved with that are relevant to Friends; 5-10 emails per week. *Note: All are asked to follow specific guidelines.*
- Cambridge Young Adult Friends (YAF) Listserv: Communications among Cambridge Friends in their late teens (post high school) through mid-30s. 1-2 announcements per week about FMC YAF gatherings, as well as relevant announcements from the broader Quaker community.
- Youth & Family Email: Weekly emails (Jan-June) from the First Day School and Youth & Family Programs Coordinators with upcoming happenings relevant to children, youth, and/or parents of this age group. For youth, parents, First Day School teachers, and members of committees that do related work.
- Youth Group Email: Occasional emails from the Youth & Family Programs Coordinator with information about events for the Youth Group (jr/sr high youth) and their parents/guardians.
